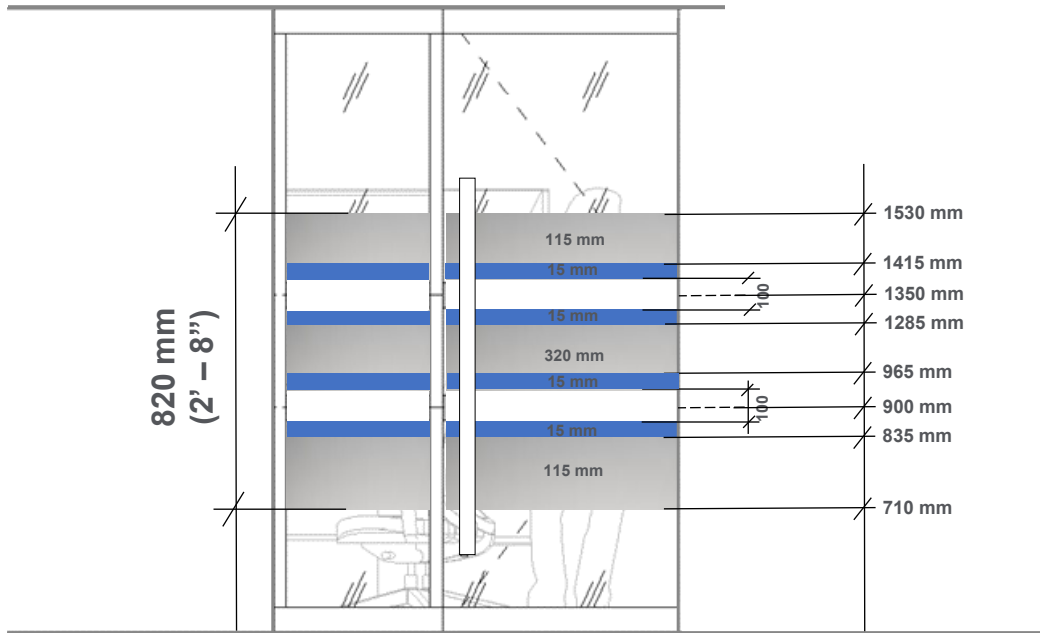





## Privacy Film & Distraction Band

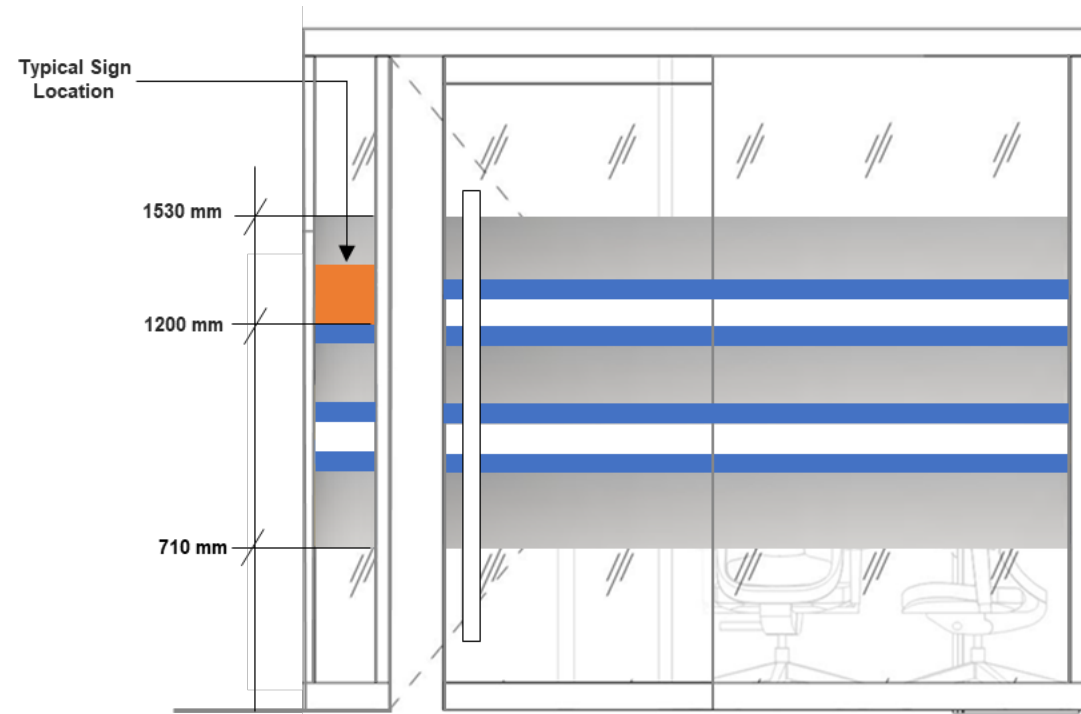
Distraction bands are a code-mandated strip of film on all glass partitions, to enhance visibility. Privacy film can be used to enhance the space through branding and wayfinding, above the code-mandated minimum.



-  Distraction Band (minimum OBC requirement): Two (2) 100 mm high white matte/opaque strips. First strip is located at 1350 mm above finished floor (AFF), and the second strip is located between 850-1000 mm AFF.
-  Privacy Film (Dusted Crystal or similar translucent film): To begin at 710 mm AFF and end at 1530 mm AFF. Top and bottom privacy strips are 115 mm wide and middle privacy strip is 320 mm wide.
-  Clear Space: 15 mm of clear space to be above and below the Distraction Band.

## Signage Mounting

Where glass door and sidelight exist, sign to be glass mounted, with vinyl second surface backing.



Bottom of sign to be mounted at 1200 mm AFF and 100 mm from the edge of the door frame.
